EL SEGUNDO, Calif. – Space Systems Command’s Battle Management Command, Control and Communications (BMC3) Program Executive Office will award a \$900 million Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contract to 18 contractors (see attached) to provide Data Software Services that directly support warfighter needs. All Contractors were chosen on a best-value basis, with a heavy emphasis on their commercial software solution and current accreditation or plan/ability to obtain accreditation.
